## Agreement of Co-operation

# ICE/ Asociación de Ingenieros de Caminos, Canales y Puertos

This Agreement of Co-operation is made between: the Institution of Civil Engineers, henceforth referred to as 'ICE', whose headquarters are located at One Great George Street, Westminster, London, United Kingdom and Asociación de Ingenieros de Caminos, Canales y Puertos henceforth referred to as 'AICCP', whose offices are located at General Arrando 38, 28010 Madrid together "the Institutions" and each an "Institution", whereby it is agreed as follows:

## Preamble

1. ICE and the AICCP have entered into this Agreement to promote the development of a closer working relationship, to the mutual benefit of their members and in the interests of advancing the engineering profession and benefitting society.

## Reciprocal Arrangements

2. The following facilities will be made available to members of each Institution who are resident in either host country:
  - a Attendance at meetings of the host Institution (other than Annual and Special General Meetings which are concerned with internal business), where applicable and on invitation.
  - b Participation in the activities of any local associations, branches or groups in the host country on invitation.
3. Where appropriate, joint sponsoring of seminars, conferences and meetings of mutual interest will be encouraged.

## Preferential Membership Arrangements

4. ICE will apply a discount to the appropriate subscription fee for Associate Membership (AMICE) for eligible members of AICCP.

## Marketing and Promotion

5. Each Institution may make reference to this Agreement in any advertising or promotion provided that the detail has been discussed with, and agreed by, the other Institution.
6. The Institutions reserve the right to request the immediate withdrawal of promotional materials that do not comply with their corporate identity and/or include inappropriate or misleading information.



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## Review, Amendment and Termination

7. This Agreement, and any subsequent attachments or schedules authorised by the Institutions, will remain in place for a period of three years from the commencement date 15 September 2017, unless terminated by either Institution by giving a minimum of six months' notice in writing.
8. The Agreement will be subject to revision, modification or renewal at any time by mutual written consent of both Institutions.

## Notices and Communication

9. The Institutions shall nominate designated contacts who will, on behalf of each Institution, liaise on strategic matters and review the relationship between the Institutions.
